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GUIDELINES FOR CHART REVIEW

PEDIATRICS

1. Use or Pediatric Growth Charts Always Mostly Sometimes Never
2. Use of Rourke Developmental records outlining milestones reached, anticipatory guidance, etc. Always Mostly Sometimes Never

OBSTETRICS

1. Use of current Saskatchewan Prenatal record Always Mostly Sometimes Never
2. Information about gestational age with documentation of last menstrual period, early ultrasound, and establishment of gestational age with preference given to the first available ultrasound scan after seven weeks gestation. Always Mostly Sometimes Never
3. Documentation of the offering of aneuploidy screening with it either marked as “declined” or the ordering of gestational age specific i.e. first trimester or second trimester testing. Always Mostly Sometimes Never
4. Documentation of medications taken or prescribed. Always Mostly Sometimes Never
5. Regular visits, with completion of the prenatal record for such visits, every four weeks as less than 28 weeks gestation. Always Mostly Sometimes Never
6. Arrangements for referral for obstetrical care and delivery if the doctor being assessed does not herself/himself provide intrapartum care. Always Mostly Sometimes Never
